Rules for all Team Cup Meets

- **Maximum of 4 gymnasts per level on each event for each club**
- The Top three scores in each class on each event count toward the team total.
- Division 1 and Division 2 Scores are combined– Division 2 competitors will be awarded any bonuses performed
- May use specialists
- No qualifying score to enter
- No Gymnasts over 16 years old.
- **Combined score is determined by combining level 4, 5 and 6 team scores**
